

Rule Book on Forming and Work of the Scientific Advisory Board of the Serbian Association of Large Animal Practitioners

Article 1

The Rule Book on forming and work of the Scientific Advisory Board (hereinafter referred to as: SAB) as a body of the Serbian Association of Large Animal Practitioners (hereinafter referred to as: SALAP) is adopted by the SALAP Management Board.

Article 2

The SAB activity is in accordance with the SALAP goals, and it specifically refers to research development and various forms of research and professional cooperation between veterinarians and other specialists who work with the ungulates or are interested in this field.

Article 3

As a part of its activities, the SALAP SAB contributes to the implementation of professional plans and work programme, and takes part in the organization of professional seminars aimed at professional education of large animal veterinarians.

Article 4

An SAB member can be a scientist or a professional in the field of biology, human medicine, veterinary medicine, pharmacy and related activities, whose scientific expertise is linked with the researches in the field of veterinary medicine of ungulates.

Article 5

The SAB consists of maximum five members appointed by the Management Board for a period of two years, with unlimited right of re-election to the same position.

The Chairman of the SAB is appointed by the Management Board for a period of two years, with unlimited right of re-election to the same position.

Article 6

The SAB convenes at least once a year and submits a report on its work to the Management Board.

Article 7

This Rule Book was drafted and came to effect as of the date of its signing by the SALAP President.
